Thursday, April 14, at 4:30 pm Villa Monterey Clubhouse



#### Village Hiking

On the second Friday (for over a year) we've been having one hour/one mile walks as an introduction to hiking, with limited success. .... We've decided to reduce that effort to every other month and to add (starting this month) more challenging trips to the West Fortuna section of Mission Trails Regional Park (MTRP), an area near our community.

1.5 hour/1.5 + mile, West Fortuna section of MTRP (Rim Trail, & back): On Fri, 08 Apr 2016 (second Friday) at 9 AM, we gather at the intersection of Calle de Vida & Colina Dorada. (Drive east on Tierrasanta Blvd to the last right turn - on to Rueda Drive, go three blocks & turn left on Calle de Vida, go to Colina Dorada, stop.) We walk along the edge of a long plateau next to a wide valley - up against a mountain ridge.

Two hour/two + mile, Tierrasanta Canyons (Promesa Plateau loop): On Fri, 22 Apr 2016 (fourth Friday) at 9 AM, we gather at Pendiente Court. (Drive east on Tierrasanta Blvd to the last left turn -

Colina Dorada, go one block, turn left to Pendiente Court: drive to the end of the cul de sac. This route shows the diversity of Tierrasanta canyon hike options.
