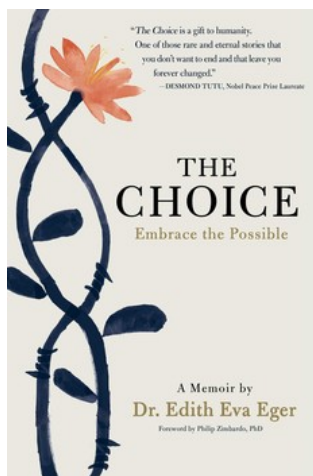

Village Hiking

Two hour/two + mile (Mission Trails), Shepherd Pond (/Tunnel) Loop On **Fri, 10 Nov 2017 (second Friday) at 9 AM**, we gather on Playa Cancun. (Drive east on Clairemont Mesa Blvd to Via Vallarta - by Catholic Church, turn left. Go past the Chinese Community Church to Playa Cancun, turn right. Open space appears on the right; go up to the gate opposite 5132 Playa Cancun, stop/park.) There's a gradual up-slope trek, then a 150 foot climb (on a 6 foot wide graded utility road) to the top of the mesa, then along the rim trail, and back down to the starting point. The route is partially 3 foot wide trail, & partly 6 foot wide graded gravel road. Chaparral is the predominant vegetation.. Bringing a hiking stick is recommended.

Two hour/two + mile (Tierrasanta Trails), Power-line Canyon (down)-Rueda (up)-Promesa Plateau (level) Loop. **Fri, 24 Nov 2017 (fourth Friday) at 9 AM**, we gather on Calle de Vida (under the power-lines). (Drive east on Clairemont Mesa Blvd. to the last right turn - Rueda Drive. Go south three blocks to Calle de Vida, turn left; drive a short distance to near the power-lines, stop/park.) This loop gives a good overview to some of the canyons we have in Tierrasanta. The view goes all the way to San Diego State University. The route is mainly utility roads, but there is some cross country. Bringing a hiking stick - we have some loaners, is definitely a good idea, as is long pants - to protect the legs.
